		<p>The climate in the greater area of Inhambane is fairly balanced and moderate, with temperatures dropping only by a few degrees during the dry winter months between May and October. Winter evenings can be cooler but temperatures rarely drop below 16 degrees, ideal months for travelers who prefer more moderate temperatures! Whale season starts from June with the humpbacks migrating South until approximately August. August up until October are months suitable for kite surfing with the wind picking up. Summers are hot and humid, with corresponding water temperatures averaging at 26 degrees - a perfect temperature throughout the day. Diving around Inhambane is possible all year around. Summer nights are warm and we are thankful for the light breeze we mostly experience at Travessia!</p>
